Upon arrival at Klahanie, guests are greeted by the expanse of the Great Lawn and striking presence of the Lodge. Inspired by the forms of local First Nations longhouses, the Lodge enjoys breathtaking views of the iconic Shannon Falls and celebrates the visual connections between the Falls and the Stawamus Chief, with the waters of Howe Sound.



RENDEZVOUS AT THE LODGE

Hosting the resort check-in, fine dining restaurant, lounge, cooking school, event space and gift boutiques, the Klahanie experience is rooted in the communal spaces of the Lodge. With dramatic double height ceilings and a sweeping central staircase, the architecture of the Lodge offers guests spectacular panoramic views from within the beauty of the contemporary space.



A LIFE OF LUXURY & EASE

The Lodge hosts 30 Resort Rooms, offering water views across Howe Sound and mountain vistas featuring the Chief. Stepping down from the Lodge towards Darrell Bay, a protected walkway and cascading water fall connects guests to 50 luxury Terrace Suites and the Spa and Wellness Retreat. Each Terrace Suite enjoys 775 square feet of uninterrupted water views complete with private patio and outdoor heated pool.



A PRIVATE SANCTUARY

Accommodations at Klahanie are luxurious in every detail – from quality furnishings, to beautifully curated décor. Articulated to showcase both landscape views while ensuring guest privacy, each room is a private sanctuary. Upon the forested point, with unparalleled views across Howe Sound, 16 exquisite Villas, accessed only by a private foot bridge, sit majestically above the water. At 1,600 square feet, the Villas cater to parties large or small. Featuring direct access to Darrell Bay and the Concierge Dock, the Klahanie Villas are the ultimate getaway experience.

Nestled among rugged outcrops and coastal forests, sitting above the waters of Howe Sound are the Residences at Klahanie. 45 luxury homes form an exclusive enclave within the Resort, each featuring infinite waterfront views, framed by contemporary west coast architecture. At 33,000 square feet, the spa sets the bar for exclusive whole body health. The retreat features indoor and outdoor pools, fitness suite, spa treatment facilities, and health and wellness classes. The outdoor deck, featuring a series of pools and therapeutic basins, allows guests to feel connected with the great outdoors.



A CULINARY EXPERIENCE

Positioned within the Lodge is the Klahanie Cooking School. Guests are mentored in the art of west coast culinary practice through hands-on instruction from award winning Chefs with a passion and flare for celebrating locally sourced, sustainable regional cuisine. On the northern bank of Shannon Creek, luxurious canvas tents are perched within the temperate rainforest. CREEKSID INDULGENCE

Above the breathtaking water flowing through Shannon Creek sits the Falls Pavilion. With spectacular views stretching across Howe Sound, the water edge Pavilion features a restaurant and patio for the enjoyment of guests and visitors to relax and celebrate after the days adventures. The Pavilion incorporates the Canopy Suites guest-only lounge, swimming pool and concierge.

From the Pavilion, forested pathways provide guests and visitors an opportunity to explore the south bank of Shannon Creek leading to the Gardens - a stunning oasis of native west coast flora and fauna.





CHOOSE YOUR ADVENTURE

From dipping your toes in the Sound to embarking on marine adventures, Klahanie has a full-service Activity Dock providing the opportunity for concierge boat storage, adventure tours and equipment rentals. Located at the edge of Darrell Bay, the dock accommodates boat and plane arrivals as well as a cafe for resort guests to enjoy refreshments on the water.

Less than a 5-minute walk from Klahanie sits the Sea-to-Sky Gondola, operating in full swing since 2014. 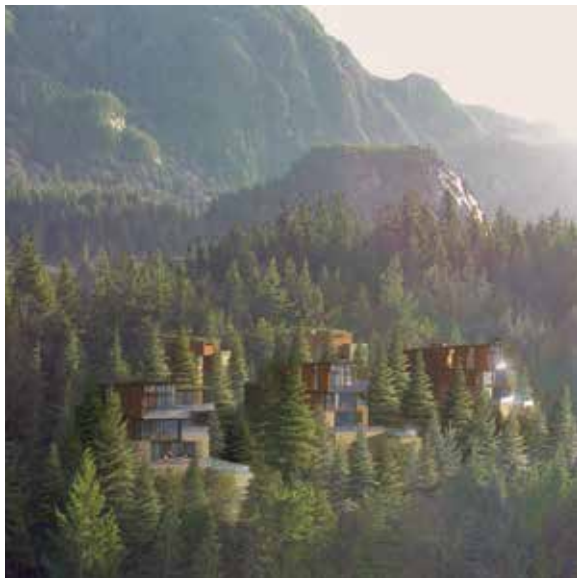
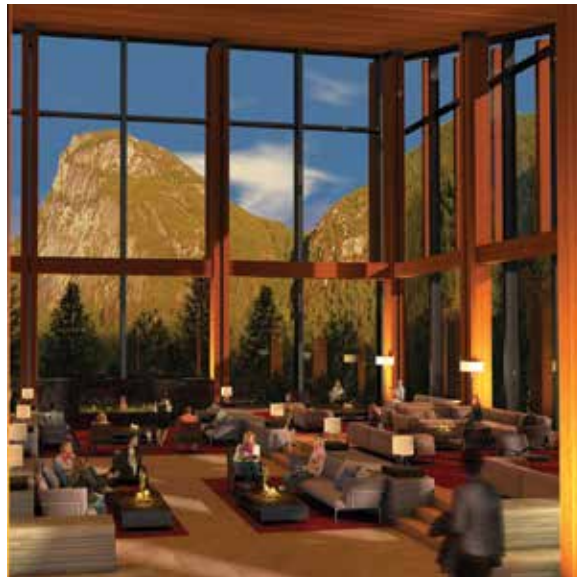
ON OUR DOORSTEP
